





The Phil Lee-Kelland Scholarship is an annual award we made to remember our former teacher and friend.

Phil worked here for 5 years and knew the school, our team, and pupils very well because he was always happy to meet people from around the world!

We are offering places to study at Purley Language College to students who can demonstrate a passion for life and learning English like Phil did.

There are 3 scholarship prizes, in 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. The first-place entry wins a completely free 3-week stay at Purley Language College, plus more!

We are looking for students who can write a story or essay, or make a presentation or video which talks about the ideas Phil was passionate about.



To enter the competition and win the scholarship, you need to submit a piece of work about one of Phil's passions or favourite things.

Age 16-21: please write 200-350 words, or submit a 3-4 minute video

Age 22-28: please write 400-500 words, or submit a 4-5 minute video

You need to complete <u>the form</u> to enter.

We would like to know a bit about yourself, and you can submit your competition piece.

You can write a story, or an essay, or you can record a video of yourself giving a presentation or speech

You can copy or type your story or essay into the form. For videos you need to put it on youtube and tell us the link on the form e.g www.youtube.co.uk/watch?v=dQw4w9WgXcQ

You should send us your work by 30 November 2019. We will choose a winner by 15th December 2019.

The prize must be used by 30th August 2020.

We will contact all winners with the exact terms of the scholarship and will list the winners on our website.

How will my work be judged?

The winning entries will be judged by a careful process involving many individuals from the college and outside. The judges include our team past and present, our pupils, and Phil's loved ones.

We will be looking at effort, originality, depth of thought, and exploration of the ideas that Phil held dear. We know you are students-your English level is not being tested. Phil loved mistakes in English that came from trying to express yourself so don't be shy!

Terms and conditions

- 1. Purley Language College reserves the right to determine the dates of study.
- 2. Prizes do not include transport tickets, flights, activities, insurance or entrances to attractions. Winners must cover any additional and unforeseen expenses themselves.
- 3. Purley Language College will choose the homestay family; the room may be shared with another student of the same gender.
- 4. The prizes are non-transferrable.
- 5. The prizes must be used within 1 year of the awardee being notified.
- 6. Awardees will be notified by email and communication with the school will be by email.
- 7. The College's decision is final and binding.

Phil was one of our staff members for 5 years. He started by leading excursions, but he was so popular and so good at helping students with their English that he soon trained to be an English teacher. He represented Purley Language College in Korea and Italy as well as London, and loved to travel the world. He described himself as 'probably the most photographed person in the world' because everyone wanted a picture with his big smile!

His favourite places in the world were ones where he either found a lot of excitement and business, or complete peace and quiet. Although he loved nightlife and dancing, he also would spend hours quietly looking at trees or the sea - and if he could do that with a new friend from a different place then that was better! He particularly loved Italy and Baltic countries.
